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STATEMENT OF JEAN YVES LE DRIAN FOREIGN AFFAIRS MINISTER IN SOLIDARITY TO BRITISH PEOPLE-----

First of all, I want to express my absolute solidarity with the British authorities and the British people after the new attack that struck the United Kingdom last night, killing several people and injuring dozens. My thoughts go first to the victims of this despicable act. I offer my condolences to their families. I also think of the many wounded. I am naturally on the side of our four wounded compatriots, to whom our embassy in London gives its full support. I want to reiterate our total determination to continue together with all our European and international partners the fight against terrorism.

The Minister of Europe and Foreign Affairs, Jean-Yves Le Drian, expresses his total solidarity with our British ally in the face of London's terrorist attack. The Ministry is closely monitoring the situation on the ground. A message of vigilance was circulated to our compatriots. The services of the French embassy in the United Kingdom are mobilized and are in close contact with the British authorities to ensure the safety of the French people in London.
